- 1. Enter your company's IRS/EIN#, OR your Social Security number, OR Customs assigned number (if foreign).
- 2. Mark the box which indicates your type of company.
- 3. Enter your **company name** (or your own name if applying a Social Security #).
- 4. Enter your **type of company** (same as box marked above).
- 5. Insert the State of Incorporation.
- 6. Enter your Corporate Address or Partnership Address, if an Individual, your Personal Address.
- 7. Enter the full legal name of company.
- 8. Sign & Print name of person completing the form (see below section on signatures).
- 9. Enter signatory's capacity/title (see below section on signatures).
- 10. Enter today's date .
- 11. CONTINUE TO FOLLOWING PAGE OF DOCUMENT: If a Partnership, Certification (11a) needs to be filled out indicating the names of the partners and signed by a partner authorized to do so. If a NON-RESIDENT Corporation (foreign entity), Certification (11b) should be completed. If a non-resident corporation has not qualified to conduct business under state law in the state in which Customs district the agent is empowered to perform the delegated authority, the power of attorney shall be supported by the certification establishing the authority of the grantor designated to execute the power of attorney on behalf of the corporation.
- 12. Please attach documentation from the IRS showing your IRS number and address. No W-9's are acceptable.
